**प्रस्तावना:-**

भारताच्या संविधानात, स्त्री-पुरुष भेद न ठेवता समानतेचे तत्व हा नागरीकांचा मूलभूत हक्क मानण्यात आला आहे. तसेच महिलांच्या बाबतीतही घटनेत सकारात्मक घोरण स्विकारण्यात आले आहे. महिलांना पुरुषांच्या बरोबरीने संधी देणे अपेक्षित असले तरी विविध शिक्षण अभ्यासक्रमांकरिता स्त्रियांना समान संधी प्रस्थापित मिळत नाही. स्त्रियांच्या शैक्षणिक उन्नतीसाठी त्यादृष्टीने खरा प्रयत्न करणे आवश्यक आहे. त्यानुसार महिलांचे बलशालीकरण आणि समाजाच्या सर्व क्षेत्रांमध्ये महिलांचा सक्रिय सहभाग करून सर्वांगीण मानवी विकासाच्या विविध क्षेत्रांमध्ये सकारात्मक परिणाम घडवून आणण्यासाठी महिलांच्या शिक्षणकडे आणि पूर्वक लक्ष देणे आवश्यक आहे. ही बाब विचारात घेऊन शासन निर्णय दि.२२.६.१९९४ अन्वये शासनाने महिलांना शासकीय नोकरीमध्ये ३० टक्के जागा आरक्षित ठेवल्या आहेत. सामाजिक खरा हेतू साध्य होण्याकरिता आता महिलांना पदवी अभ्यासक्रमांकरिता ३० टक्के आरक्षण ठेवणे आवश्यक आहे. त्यानुसार महाराष्ट्र राज्यात पदवी स्तरावरील सर्व अभ्यासक्रमांकरिता महिलांसाठी ३० टक्के आरक्षण ठेवण्याबाबत शासनाचा विचार होता.

**शासन निर्णय:-**

वरील सर्व वस्तुस्थिती विचारात घेऊन शासन आता असे आदेश देत आहे की, महाराष्ट्र राज्यातील सर्व पारंपारिक विद्यापीठे व त्यांना संलग्नित असलेल्या सर्व शासकीय, अनुदानित व विनियुक्तित महविद्यालयांतील पदवी अभ्यासक्रमांच्या प्रवेशाकरिता महिलांसाठी ३० टक्के आरक्षण ठेवण्यात येत आहे.

सदरचे आरक्षण बिनराखीव व राखीव या दोन्ही प्रवर्गांसाठी लागू राहिल. जर बिनराखीव जागा १०० असतील तर त्यापैकी ३० जागा महिलांकरिता आरक्षित राहतील.

तसेच सदरचे आरक्षण हे सध्या विविध सामाजिक प्रवर्गांकरिता विहित केलेल्या संविधानात्मक राष्ट्रीय जागा अंतर्गत समंतर आरक्षण (Horizontal) राहिल. उदाहरणार्थ जसे की, सध्या संविधानातील तरतुदीनुसार शासनाने अनुसूचित जातीच्या प्रवर्गांतील विद्यार्थ्यांकरिता १३ टक्के जागा आरक्षित आहेत. त्यापैकी त्यातील ३० टक्के आरक्षण हे अनुसूचित जाती या प्रवर्गांतील महिला उमेदवारांकरिताच ठेवण्यात येईल व जर या प्रवर्गांतील किमान पात्रता असलेल्या महिला उमेदवार प्राप्त न झाल्यास त्या जागा अनुसूचित जातीच्या प्रवर्गांतील पुरुष संवर्गांतून भरण्यात येतील. म्हणजेच जर प्रवेशाकरिता पन्नास विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी प्रथम वर्षासाठी १०९ जागा असतील तर त्यापैकी १३ जागा अनुसूचित जातीच्या प्रवर्गांतील उमेदवारांकरिता सध्या असलेले आरक्षण विचारात घेऊन त्यापैकी ३० टक्के म्हणजेच ४ जागा ह्या अनुसूचित जातीच्या प्रवर्गांतील महिला उमेदवारांकरिता आरक्षित राहतील.

एच-२३९(१०००-४-००) (कृ.मा.प.)

वर उल्लेखिलेल्या पध्दतीनेच इतर सर्व प्रवर्गांकरिताही सध्या असलेल्या आरक्षणांतर्गत महिलांना ३० टक्के समांतरपणे आरक्षण ठेवण्यात येईल. तसेच ज्या पदवी अभ्यासक्रमांकरिता मूल्यभावीत व मुक्त जागांवर देण्यात येतात ह्या प्रवेशा अंतर्गत देखील ३० टक्के आरक्षण महिलांकरिता देण्यात येईल.

सध्या सर्व तंत्र निकेतनांमध्ये पदविका अभ्यासक्रमासाठी महिलांकरिता शासन निर्णय क्र. डब्ल्यूबीपी-१०९५/(२७१९)व्यशि-५, दि. १७.१.१९९६ अन्वये ठेवलेल्या २५ टक्के आरक्षणात वाढ करून आता ते ३० टक्के इतके करण्यात येत आहे..

सदरच्या आरक्षित जागांवर जर महिला उमेदवार उपलब्ध झाल्या नाहीत तर या रिक्त जागा त्याच शैक्षणिक वर्षात पुरुष संवर्गांतून भरण्यात येतील व या रिक्त जागांचा त्या पुढील शैक्षणिक वर्षात अनुशंभ धरला जाणार नाही.

वैद्यकीय शिक्षण विभाग आणि कृषि व पशु विभागांतर्गत येणाऱ्या सर्व पदवी अभ्यासक्रमांकरिता आदेश संबंधित विभागांकडून स्वतंत्रपणे निर्गमित करण्यात येतील.

सदरचे आरक्षणविषयक आदेश शैक्षणिक वर्ष सन २००९-२०१० पासून अंमलात येतील. महाराष्ट्राचे राज्यपाल यांच्या आदेशानुसार व नांवाने.

## Translation of the above GR into Marathi

### Preface:-

In the Constitution of India, the principle of equality without distinction between men and women is considered as a fundamental right of citizens. Also, in the case of women, a positive policy has been adopted in the constitution. Although women are expected to be given equal opportunities to men, women do not actually get equal opportunities for various educational courses. It is necessary to make a real effort for the educational upliftment of women. Accordingly, it is necessary to give conscious attention to the education of women to bring about positive results in various areas of all-round human development through women's empowerment and active participation of women in all sectors of society. Taking this matter into consideration, the government has reserved 30 percent seats for women in government jobs under the government decision dated 22.6.1994. In order to achieve the real purpose behind this, it is now necessary to keep 30 percent reservation for women in degree courses. Accordingly, the government was thinking of keeping 30 percent reservation for women for all degree level courses in the state of Maharashtra.

### Governance Decision:-

Taking all the above facts into consideration, the government is now ordering that 30 percent reservation for women for admission to degree courses in all the traditional universities and their affiliated government, aided and unaided colleges in the state of Maharashtra.

The said reservation will be applicable for both unreserved and reserved categories. If there are 100 unreserved seats, then 30 seats will be reserved for women.

• Also, the said reservation will remain parallel reservation (Horizontal) under the constitutional reservation currently prescribed for various social classes. For example, currently, as per the provisions of the constitution, the government has reserved 13 percent seats for students belonging to the Scheduled Caste category. Out of which 30% reservation will be reserved for women candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste category and if women candidates with minimum qualification of this category are not received then those seats will be filled from male cadre of Scheduled Caste category. That is, if there are 109 seats for admission in a faculty for the first year, out of which 13 seats will be reserved for women candidates from Scheduled Caste category and 30% i.e. 4 seats will be reserved for Scheduled Caste category candidates.

30 percent reservation for women under the existing reservation will also be kept for all other categories in the same manner as mentioned above. Also, 30 percent reservation will be given to women under this admission for degree courses which are offered on value-laden and vacant seats.


At present, the 25 percent reservation for women for diploma courses in all technical institutes has been increased to 30 percent vide Govt.

If female candidates are not available on the said reserved seats, then these vacancies will be filled from the male cadre in the same academic year and these vacancies will not be kept backlog in the next academic year.

Orders for all degree courses coming under the Department of Medical Education and the Department of Agriculture and Agriculture will be issued separately by the respective departments.

The said reservation orders will come into effect from the academic year 2006-2007.

### Introduction :-

The Central Government has published The rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, dated 28th December, 2016 in the Gazette. Section 32 of this Act provides as follows:-

- १) All Government institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five per cent seats for persons with benchmark disabilities.
- २) The person with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission in institutions of higher education.

According to the provisions of this Act of the Central Government, it is necessary to reserve 5 percent seats for persons/students with significant disabilities in various government and non-government aided institutions providing degree and post-graduate education under the Directorate of Technical Education.

### Government Decision :-

As per the provisions of Section 32 (1) of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 significant disability in various government and non-government aided institutions providing degree and post graduate education under Directorate of Technical Education.

The government has decided to reserve 5 percent seats for existing persons/students. This decision should be implemented from the academic year 2018-19. For this, necessary amendments should be made in the admission rules of various courses.

**प्रस्तावना :** उपरोक्त दिनांक २६ जुलै, १९९५ व दिनांक १५ सप्टेंबर, १९९५ च्या शासन निर्णयान्वये विहित करण्यात आलेल्या २०० बिंदू व ५० बिंदू नामावल्या मागे घेण्यात येत असल्याची घोषणा दि. १९ डिसेंबर १९८५ रोजी विधान परिषदेत झालेल्या चर्चेच्या वेळी शासनातर्फे करण्यात आली. त्या अनुषंगाने, उपरोक्त क्रमांक-३ येथील दिनांक १५ फेब्रुवारी, १९९६ च्या शासन निर्णयान्वये, घोषणेच्या दिनांकापासून म्हणजेच दिनांक १९ डिसेंबर, १९९५ पासून, २०० बिंदू व ५० बिंदू नामावल्या मागे घेण्यात आल्या. मात्र दरम्यानच्या काळात कामकाजाची अडचण होऊ नये म्हणून तात्पुरती २०० बिंदू/५० बिंदू नामावली विहित करण्यात आली. बिंदू नामावली सुधारित करण्याचा प्रश्न शासनाच्या काही काळ विचाराधीन होता.

**शासन निर्णय :** सरळसेवा प्रवेशासाठी व पदोन्नतीसाठी बिंदू नामावल्या सुधारित करण्याच्या प्रश्नासंदर्भात शासनाने मा. उपमुख्यमंत्री यांच्या अध्यक्षतेखाली एक समिती गठित केली होती. या समितीने केलेल्या शिफारशीनुसार सरळसेवा प्रवेशासाठी सुधारित १०० बिंदू नामावली व पदोन्नतीसाठी सुधारित ५० बिंदू नामावली याद्वारे विहित करण्यात येत आहेत. सुधारित बिंदू नामावलीचा नमुना सोबत जोडला आहे.

**Foreword:-** The announcement of the withdrawal of 200 points and 50 points as prescribed in the above Government Resolutions dated: 26th July, 1995 and dated: 15th September, 1995 was announced by the Government during the discussion held in the Legislative Council on 19th December, 1995. . Accordingly vide Government Decision dated 15th February, 1996 at No-3 above, 200 points and 50 points were withdrawn from the date of announcement ie: 19th December, 1995. But in the meantime, a temporary list of 200 points and 50 points was prescribed in order not to cause problems in the work. The question of revising the point list was under the consideration of the government for some time.

**Government Decision:** Regarding the issue of revising point names for direct service entry and promotion, the government has asked Hon. A committee was formed under the chairmanship of Deputy Chief Minister. As per the recommendation made by this committee, a revised 100 point list for direct service entry and a revised 50 point list for admission are being prescribed. A sample of revised point nomenclature is attached.

2. The proceedings in this matter have been completed before the date of this decision. There is no need to revise it. However, henceforth, in relation to direct service recruitment and posts, following the revised point list, up to the number of points previously used according to the existing Hindu list, adopting the revised point list from the established point, but if there is a backlog before that, it should be considered at the time of direct service recruitment. Exempt castes will remain internally transferable under reservation in categories "A", "B", "C" and "D" for direct service to nomadic tribes.

3. Appropriate instructions should be given in this regard to all the Government Offices under their control so that the Departments should adopt this revised point list at the time of direct service recruitment and promotion. Appropriate orders should be issued by the concerned ministerial departments regarding the implementation of these orders in semi-government service boards etc.

**Regarding reservation of 10% seats for  
admission to government services and  
educational institutions for economically  
weaker sections of open category**

**Introduction -**

Parliament has passed the 103rd Constitutional Amendment Act, 2019. Article 15 and 16 of the Constitution of India have been amended thereby. Clause (6) has been included in Article 15 of the State Constitution by the said constitutional amendment. According to this amendment, any special provision may be made for the advancement of citizens of economically weaker sections other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5) of Article 15, and also for the economically weaker sections other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5) in clause (1) of Article 30. The State Government may reserve up to 10% of seats in educational institutions other than the mentioned minority educational institutions as well as in private educational institutions, whether they are subsidized or non-subsidized by the State Government. No provision of Article 15 or sub-clause (g) of clause (1) of Article 19 or clause (2) of Article 29 shall prevent the State from making special provision as above. This reservation will be in addition to the reservation currently prescribed for backward classes. (Explanation: For Articles 15 and 16, the economically weaker section shall be as the State Government may from time to time notify on the basis of economic income and other economic weaknesses).

Also, by amending Article 16 of the Constitution by including Clause (6) therein, it has been provided that the State shall not be prevented from keeping up to 10% reservation for economically weaker sections in Government services apart from the reservation mentioned in Clause (4) of Article 16. The Constitution Amendment Act passed by the Parliament came into force vide the Gazette dated 14th January, 2019.

The said constitutional amendment must be implemented in the state. Considering this matter, the decision to keep 10% reservation for the economically weaker sections of the open

category for service in government / semi-government services and government activities and for admission in government, private aided and unaided institutions except for minority educational institutions was under the consideration of the government. Accordingly the State Government is taking the following decision :-

**Government Decision:-**

Government educational institutions/ aided schools, colleges, all higher education imparting educational institutions, unaided schools for the economically weaker sections of the state (backward classes) other than the classes given the benefit of reservation under Article 15 (4) and (5) and Article 16 (4) of the Constitution of India. , 10% reservation is being prescribed in total admission seats in colleges and educational institutions. The said reservation shall not apply to minority institutions referred to in Clause (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution.

Also, 10% reservation is being prescribed in direct service posts for appointment in government establishments, semi-government establishments, boards / corporations / urban local bodies / rural local bodies, authorities for the economically weaker sections of the state.

**2. The benefit of reservation for economically weaker sections shall be admissible subject to the following conditions :-**

(A) Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections of the State in the Maharashtra State Public Service Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Tribes (STs), Nomadic Tribes, Special Backward Classes and Other Backward Classes Act, 2001 (Maharashtra Act No. 8 of 2004) and Maharashtra State for Socially and Educationally Backward (SEBC) Class (for admission to seats in State Educational Institutions and Reservation of Appointments or Posts in State Controlled Public Services Act, 2018 (Maharashtra Act No. 62 of 2018) for Government Educational Institutions/ Aided Schools, Colleges for those not included , Educational Institutions, Unaided Schools, Colleges, Educational Institutions 10% reservation is being prescribed in the total seats to be admitted in. The said reservation shall not apply to minority educational institutions in terms of Clause (1) of Article 30 of the State Constitution.

Also, 10% of the posts will be reserved for economically weaker sections in all cadres of direct service posts in Government establishments, Semi-Government establishments, Boards / Corporations / Civil Local Self-Government / Rural Local Self-Government, Authorities.

(B) This 10% reservation in the state is currently prescribed under the Maharashtra State Public Service Reservation Act, 2001 (Maharashtra Act No. 8 of 2004) for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Tribes (STs), Nomadic Tribes, Special Backward Classes and Other Backward Classes. For Incoming Backward Classes and Maharashtra State Socially and Educationally Backward (SEBC) Classes (Reservation of Seats in State Educational Institutions and Reservation of Appointments or Posts in State-controlled Public Services

Act, 2018 (Maharashtra Act No. 62 of 2018) shall be in addition to the reservation prescribed for socially and educationally backward sections .

**(C) Eligibility for benefit of reservation for economically weaker sections:-**

(1) An applicant/candidate whose combined annual income of the family is within Rs.8 lakhs will be considered economically weaker candidate and will be eligible for the benefit of this reservation.

(2) Family for the benefit of this reservation shall include the applicant's/candidate's parents and siblings below 18 years of age as well as applicant's/candidate's children below 18 years of age and spouse. The combined income of the family shall include the income of the members of his family from all sources i.e. wages, agricultural income, business and all other sources, the annual income of the preceding financial year as on the date of filing of application should be less than Rs.8 lakh.

(3) In order to benefit from the reservation for economically weaker sections, it shall be mandatory to submit the eligibility certificate from the competent authority in the format prescribed herewith (Annexure-A). Also, the application form to be submitted (Annexure-B), the documents/evidence to be attached with the application (Annexure-C) and the declaration form (Annexure-D) shall be as per the attached specimen.

(4) In order to avail of this reservation, the person or his family should be a resident of the State of Maharashtra on or before 13th October, 1967.

(5) The age, examination fee and other concessions allowed to the candidates in the said category shall be as per the rules applied by the State Government from time to time to the other backward categories.

**(D) Procedure regarding Eligibility Certificate-**

(1) Tehsildar is being declared as the competent authority for issuing eligibility certificate for the benefit of reservation for economically weaker sections and the Collector shall have power to declare more than one Tehsildar as the competent authority if necessary.

(2) It shall be mandatory to issue the eligibility certificate to the beneficiary within one month (within 30 days) from the date of receipt of the application along with the necessary documents from the beneficiary for obtaining the required eligibility certificate for economically weaker section. If the same is refused or given wrongly, the procedure for filing an appeal against the same is prescribed as follows.

(i) The appellate officer against the decision of the competent authority shall be the Sub-Collector of his jurisdiction or an officer not below the rank of Sub-Collector nominated by the Collector.

(i) The Collector of his jurisdiction shall remain the appellate authority against the decision of the appellate officer mentioned in (1) above.

(ii) The aforesaid appellate authority shall be bound to give a decision within one month (within 30 days) from the date of receipt of the appeal.

**(E) Date of reservation point and benefit of reservation under this reservation:-**

1) For the category included under this reservation as fixed vide Government Decision dated 29.03.1997 and dated 5.12.2018 of the General Administration Department. Bindu number 8, 16, 26, 38, 46, 56, 68, 76, 86, 98 in the 100-bindu list will be reserved.

2) (a) The date of implementation of 10% reservation for economically weaker sections in the State shall be 01.02.2019.

(b) Also since the Act made under the 103rd Amendment came into force on January 14, 2019 this reservation will also be applicable to the posts in which the posts are included in the advertisement and admission process as per 10% reservation for economically weaker section during the period from 14th January, 2019 to 31st January, 2019.

3) Out of the candidates who have applied for appointment prior to the date of this order as well as during the period as mentioned in (b) above and those who have applied for appointment as per the advertisement/admission process for which the posts are covered as mentioned therein and who are not included in the backward categories under the Acts mentioned in paragraph 2. Such candidates will be given the option to give option as to whether or not they are willing to recruit from economically weaker sections.

4) Eligibility certificate for economically weaker section will be required to be submitted from the date of this order or 6 months from the date of submission of application whichever is later.

5) Parallel reservation in service will continue to be applicable even among the economically weaker sections of the society for which parallel reservation in service is applicable.

4 .Necessary orders regarding admission to educational institutions should be issued immediately by the Departments of School Education, Higher and Technical Education, Medical Education and Medicines, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries and other concerned departments.

5. This Government Decision applies to Government / Semi-Government Services, Boards / Corporations, Municipalities / Municipal Corporations, Zilla Parishads, Government Schools, Colleges, Government Educational Institutions, Private Schools, Colleges, Educational Institutions, Aided / Unaided Schools, Colleges and Educational Institutions and whomsoever may order. The authority vested in the Government shall apply to all other authorities, services and institutions.
