- **Exam Form Records Feeding:** The online platform for filling and submitting exam forms has been adopted, improving efficiency. The submission process is now 50% faster, with minimal issues reported.

- **Library Management System:** The implementation of an online library management system has made cataloging and searching for resources more efficient. Student engagement with library services has increased by 25% since automation.
- **Digital Resources:** The library has expanded access to digital resources, allowing students and staff to utilize services more effectively. Training sessions on utilizing these digital tools have been well-attended.
